

# 1000 SASSI REGULATION

(Pending approval by IMF)

## Art. 1.0 Presentation

The 1000 SASSI is a non-competitive national motorcycle event, taking place in full compliance with the rules of the highway code, on normal roads, both "**dirt and asphalted**", open to road traffic

The purpose of the event is mainly to promote the dirt roads of our country as well as the medieval villages, the history, and the culinary culture of Italy.

## Art. 2.0 The Path

The route is about 740kms long with at least 70% dirt roads and the remaining 30% paved ones.

The route takes place entirely in Tuscany and draws a triangle. Each side of the triangle is a daily stage. The first stage will be *Figline Valdarno - Massa Marittima*, the second stage *Massa Marittima - Volterra* and the third stage *Volterra - Figline Valdarno*.

## Art. 2.1 Navigation tools

The route can be followed by the participants by means of different navigation tools like a navigator, a SmartPhone capable of reading GPX files, a paper Road Book or Tripy.

Tripy is an electronic Road Book that provides not only the path of the route but also other important indications such as the type of road surface (for example, if it is muddy, with gravel or with loose rock etc), the lengths of the asphalted and unpaved stretches (always provided in advance), indicating the beginning and the end, etc.

Tripy does not need any power sockets to be mounted on the handlebar, it can be attached and detached through a simple clamp and is very easy to use.

The Tripy is rented by the event organizer to participants, teams or groups of friends (who can share the rental cost if they wish). The route files will already have been uploaded by the organizer and the participants will just have to follow them.

## Art.2.2 Route file

The GPX files of all the routes will be provided to all participants 3 days before the beginning of the event. The participants who will use their own navigation tools like smartphones or navigators, must present themselves at the departure with the GPX files already loaded.

Participants who use the paper Road Books will receive them on the day of arrival during the preliminary operations.

Participants who will use the Tripy will be able to collect it on the day of preliminary operations between 3 and 5 pm.

The paper Road Book and / or the Tripy will be provided exclusively to the participants who have requested them during registration.

It is forbidden to disclose the routes to non-participants of the event. Any infringement will be punished in accordance with the law.

## Art. 3.0 Types of motorcycles allowed

Motorcycles must comply with road traffic laws, compliance with which is entrusted to the full responsibility of the rider also with regard to insurance aspects and compliance with current legislation. The categories of motorcycles admitted to the 1000 SASSI are the following:

### The Glorious

Twin or single cylinder motorcycles, produced up to 31/12/1994, of any weight

### The Powerful

Modern twin-cylinder or single-cylinder maxi enduro bikes weighing 150 kg or more (including all liquids).

Specialized single cylinder motorcycles are not allowed

### The Sidecars

Sidecars will be welcome

## Art. 4.0 Who can participate

All citizens of the world can participate in the event as long as they have:

- *Valid driving licence*

- *Medical certificate of sound and robust physical constitution*
- *Member Card of the Italian Motorcycle Federation*

In cases of minor age participants a written authorization with explicit acceptance of the complete regulation of the 1000 SASSI, signed from both parents (or legal guardians) and authenticated at the municipality of residence is required.

The event organization, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to refuse one or more registration requests, to individuals or teams, without any related explanation.

#### **Art. 4.1 Teams**

Individual riders are allowed to form teams consisting of a minimum of 3 up to a maximum of 6 riders. Riders are allowed to give their team a name as long as it is approved by our organization.

#### **Art. 5.0 Preliminary operations**

Preliminary operations are procedures necessary for the identification of participants and their registration upon arrival.

In order to have his/her participation confirmed, each rider must submit the originals of the following documents:

- Driving license (original)
- membership card of the Italian Motorcycle Federation 2020
- Original medical certificate of healthy and robust constitution, issued by the family doctor in 2020
- payment receipts

#### **Art. 6.0 Closed Park**

The Closed Park is a temporary parking area that will be set up in Marsilio Ficino square in Figline Valdarno where the bikes can be parked from 3 pm on June 25 until 8 am of the following day. Although our staff guards the square, our organization assumes no responsibility for any theft and / or damage of any kind.

#### **Art. 7.0 Clothing**

While riding it is always mandatory to wear technical clothing with protections, boots, gloves and approved helmet. Participants who arrive at the departure without technical clothing will not be allowed to depart. Everyone is advised to bring a backpack containing at least 1.5 liters of water and some supplements.

#### **Art. 8.0 Departure**

Each rider will be assigned a departure time at which he/she must be ready to go at the departure line. Two or three participants will depart at a time, according to the rows of the departures grid prepared by the organizer, until all participants have departed. In case a rider arrives late, he/she must remain at the disposal of the organization that will allow him/her to depart at its sole discretion, as soon as possible.

##### **June 26 - Friday**

### **June 27 - Saturday**

#### **2nd Stage**

From 7:30 to 9 am, in Massa Marittima, staggered departure of the participants.

Staggered arrival scheduled in Volterra between 5 and 7 pm

9 pm optional dinner all together (optional see Art.16)

### **June 28 - Sunday**

#### **3rd Stage and Arrival**

From 7:30 to 9 am, in Volterra, staggered departure of the participants.

Staggered arrival scheduled at Giacomo Matteotti square, Figline Valdarno (Florence) between 11.30 am and 1 pm

2.30 pm Awards, thankings and greetings

*As for the dinners on Friday and Saturday, we have deliberately left the participants the freedom to decide whether to have dinner with our staff and journalists, or go wherever they want.*

*As for accommodation, we have preferred let you decide where to stay. However we have activated an external hotel booking service and put it at the disposal of participants.*

#### **Art. 10.0 Notice of route changes to the participants**

Participants are required to follow the route provided by the organizer. No assistance is guaranteed outside this route. If a participant decides for any reason to follow a different route or to end the stage in advance "he/she can do it" but he/she has the obligation to notify the organization by telephone at the assistance number indicated by the organizer to the participants.

#### **Art. 11.0 Transit checks**

In some cases, the organization may perform CT transit checks to verify the presence of all participants. The participant will have to stop near CT transit check points and depart again as instructed by the on-spot staff.

#### **Art. 12.0 Riding conduct and penalties**

Compliance with traffic laws and local traffic regulations is mandatory and all participants must be fully informed about them.

Every participant is the sole responsible of his/her conduct during the event. At the total discretion of the event organizers, any conduct of the participants not deemed appropriate to respect safety, compliance with the Regulation and its annexes, the good evolution of the Event and the respect for people, will be sanctioned even with expulsion from the Event , without sanctioned participants having anything to claim.

#### **Art. 13.0 Tire service and sale**

The organizer provides fitting and disassembly service and supply of Pirelli or Metzeler motorcycle tires on Thursday June 25 and Sunday June 28 only for orders received and accepted in advance.

The tire fitting and disassembly service, supply and invoicing will be provided by the Eventi 2 Ruote srl company appointed by the Motolampeggio Moto Club asd. For information contact [fortugno@motolampeggio.it](mailto:fortugno@motolampeggio.it), +39 334 8841278

#### **Art. 14.0 Recovery of broken vehicles**

In case a vehicle breaks down, our road assistance vehicles will, where possible, transport it at the nearest paved road where, always if possible, we will load the vehicle on another assistance truck that will transport the broken vehicle to the current stage arrival. In case the above operations are not possible, the rider of the broken vehicle will have to call the assistance truck provided with the IMF agreement.

### Art. 15.0 Baggage transport

Baggage transport service is available. Participants' baggage will be loaded in the morning before departure and will be handed back to them at every stage arrival unless otherwise arranged by the organizer. Each baggage piece handed over must have an identification tag containing *Name, Surname and departure number of the owner*.

The organization declines any responsibility during transport for any damage to rigid bags (which are therefore not recommended) and for any theft or loss that may occur.

### Art. 16.0 Awards

At the end of the event, a jury consisting of a minimum of 3 to a maximum of 5 members will be appointed. The jury members "who will be chosen at the discretion of the organization" will award the following:

- The top 5 most beautiful bikes among **The Glorious**
- The top 5 most beautiful bikes among **The Powerful**
- All participants who have completed the run will be rewarded with a personalized medal

### Art. 17.0 Registration fee

Silver package	€ 390 only with GPX files
Gold package	€ 400 with paper road book and GPX files
Premium package	530 euros with Tripy rental and routes already loaded

Package prices are valid for one-off payments. For payments divided in two installments the registration fee will have a 30€ extra cost.

*Deferred payment can be done with a 150€ down payment upon registration and payoff within May 1.*

### **Art. 18.0 Enrollment and payment**

Delayed payments will result in loss of downpayment and reservation cancellation without refund.

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### **Art. 20.0 Withdrawal**

In case of withdrawal within April 27, the organizer will withhold 150€ of the amount paid and will refund the remainder to the withdrawn applicant. After March 27 no refund will be due by the organizer to withdrawn participants. In both cases, withdrawn participants will have nothing more to demand. The withdrawal must be communicated via email to [info@motolampeggio.it](mailto:info@motolampeggio.it). Failure to pay the fees within the set deadlines will result in exclusion from the event without any refund right on the payments already done. The registration fee will be refunded only if applicants are rejected by the organization. In case of cancellation of the event due to force majeure, the participation fee will not be refunded.

### **Art. 21.0 Communications**

At the unquestionable judgment of the organizer and if he deems it appropriate, the length of the stages can be varied and the accommodation facilities may be changed. Changes will be communicated to participants with one of the following tools: news published on website [www.1000sassi.it](http://www.1000sassi.it), WhatsApp message or, during the days of the event, with a poster affixed to the bulletin board.

### **Art. 22.0 Image rights**

By enrolling to the 1000 SASSI, the participant TACITLY AUTHORIZES the Motolampeggio Moto Club asd, organizer of the event, to the EXPLOITATION of any image rights that will be used for the creation and publication of photos, videos, articles, social network posts etc. For this purpose the Motolampeggio Moto Club asd will give mandate and AUTHORIZATION to professionals of the sector (journalists, photo-video-graphers, social media managers) in order to perform what has already been described.

**Art. 23 Jurisdiction**

All participants of the event declare as of now acceptance of the present regulation and any following modifications of it. By applying for registration to the event, applicants declare knowledge and acceptance of its regulation. For anything not mentioned in this regulation we refer to the IMF regulation.

The only court having jurisdiction on any dispute arising between the parties shall be the Court of Rome.
