



**Information Notice pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679  
of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27 2016 on the protection of individuals with  
regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, repealing the 95/46/CE  
Directive**

**WEBSITE USERS/VISITORS**

According to the article 13 of the European Union General Data Protection **Regulation 2016/679** (hereinafter referred to as "GDPR") and **Legislative Decree 196/2003** (hereinafter referred to as "Privacy Code"), as updated by Legislative Decree 101/2018, **Moto Club Motolampeggio a.s.d.** (hereinafter: "Motolampeggio" or "Data Controller"), informs those ("users" / "data subjects") who access the site [www.1000sassi.it](http://www.1000sassi.it) and on the Facebook page <https://www.facebook.com/1000-SASSI-103479687679518/> the following information.

This policy document is provided exclusively in relation to the Data Controller's website and not also in relation to other websites that can be consulted by the user through links shown or accessible on the site itself and not owned by the Data Controller.

**1.Identity and contacts of the Data Controller**

**2.Types of data processed.**

The data processed can be the following:

**Personal data**, such as any information concerning an identified or identifiable natural person ("data subject"). A natural person is considered identifiable if his/her identification can be performed directly or indirectly through an identifier like a name, an identification number, geolocation data, an online identifier or one or more elements defining its physical, physiological, genetic, psychic, economic, cultural or social identity, for example an IP address, name, surname, vat code, fiscal code, address, postal code, telephone number, fax number, email address.

*During their normal operation, computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of internet communication protocols. This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of computers and terminals used by users, URIs/URLs (Uniform Resource Identifiers/Locators) of requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response from the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and computer environment of the user.*

**3.Purposes and Lawful Basis for the Processing**

For all users of the site, their personal data may be used for:

#### **4. Communication and dissemination of personal data**

Personal data may be disclosed to specifically designated subjects, acting under the authority of the Data Controller, or to Data Processors. Data Processors belong to the following categories: email and sms marketing platform suppliers, event sponsors, legal and tax consultants of the Data Controller, webmaster and website development companies, marketing consultants, server suppliers.

If the User provides the consent referred to in purpose 3.4 of this policy, his/her data will be communicated to **Eventi 2 Ruote srl** with registered office in Via Valadier, 44, 00193 Rome, VAT ID and Fiscal Code 15143401006, which will send the User its own privacy policy.

Every data communication will be performed in the respect of the data processing purposes described above. For users registered on Facebook and Instagram platforms and who interact with our page, Facebook Inc. operates as an independent Data Controller.

The list of Data Processors can be requested to the Data Controller using contact details indicated in point 1. Personal data may be disclosed to third parties in order to comply with legal obligations, or to comply with orders from public authorities empowered by law, or to defend and assert a right in Court.



## **5. Personal data retention period**

Personal data collected for the purposes indicated in point 3.1 of this information notice will not be stored. Personal data collected for the purposes referred to in point 3.2 will be stored for the duration of the event to which the User is registered.

Personal data collected for the purposes referred to in point 3.3 will be stored for five years.

Personal data collected for the purposes indicated in points 3.4, 3.5 and 3.6 of this policy will be stored for a maximum period of five years or until the withdrawal of consent and no later than three months from the same withdrawal.

Personal data, at the end of the processing period indicated above, will be kept for a further 10 years only for justice and administrative / accounting purposes.

## **6. Data processing method**

Personal data will be processed with paper and IT tools by designated and properly instructed subjects, acting under the authority of the Data Controller and by Data Processors.

The management and storage of personal data takes place at the headquarters of the data controller and on servers located within the European Union owned and / or in the availability of the Data Controller.

**The fruition of the Data Controller's services is reserved to subjects legally able, according to national legislation, to conclude contractual obligations. The Data Controller may implement prevention measures, such as fiscal code control or other adequate measures, in order to protect his legitimate interest and prevent illegitimate access to the services provided to data subjects.**

## **7. Rights of the Data Subject**

You have the right to access your data at any time and to exercise the other rights provided for in the GDPR by contacting the contacts indicated in point 1. In particular, you have a right:

***Right to data erasure (Article 17, GDPR)***

***Right to restriction of processing (Article 18, GDPR)***

***Right to data portability (Article 20, GDPR)***

***Right to object (Article 21, GDPR)***

***The data subject has the right to not to be subjected to a decision based solely on automated processing that produces legal effects concerning him/her (art.22, GDPR) Right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (Art. 77, GDPR)***

***This privacy policy may be subject to change. Where substantial changes are applied to the processing of data of data subjects by the Controller, the latter will notify the former by publishing such changes with maximum evidence on his web pages or through alternative or similar means.***
